- **In our SuCoLo project, we have sought to improve the delivery of goods in cities:**
 - For example, we've delivered parcels using cargo bikes. And we've tried to improve parcel collection points to reduce traffic in cities.
- **In the process, we explored, learnt and wrote down many important things:**
 - These points are important and provide guidance to other towns on how to improve the delivery of goods and make it more environmentally friendly.
 - These are our recommendations on how best to plan and carry out bicycle deliveries in a city.
 - These recommendations will help you draw up plans for sustainable logistics.



What is it for?

The recommendations are helpful:

- Making cities more **environmentally friendly**
- **Improving delivery services**
- Making **more deliveries by bicycle and cargo bike**



How was it developed??

- with **trial periods** in real towns and cities: for a set period, we tested cargo bikes and collection points right there on the spot
- together with:
 - people in cities
 - shops and businesses
 - the authorities

This is how we develop solutions that are **practical and realistic**.

What is important here?

For a project involving the delivery of goods within the city to run smoothly, the following are required:

- Cooperation between all parties involved
- Good planning of the infrastructure (for example, paths and stations)
- The inclusion of everyone, including people with disabilities
